## FACILITY SECURITY TRAINING &

### USER AGREEMENT

- **Port of Texas City is currently at MARSEC Level 1.**
- Port of Texas City's Facility Security Officer is James Whitehead.
- Port of Texas City's Alternate Facility Security Officer is Brandi Flisowski.
- Port of Texas City Security Council (PTCSC) has the right to deny entry to anyone.
- Request for access to facility constitutes consent to screen all vehicles and persons.
- Person(s) refusing to such screenings will be denied access.
- All that enter this facility must possess an approved valid picture ID.
- ID's consist of pictured State Driver's License or State issued Picture ID, Federal, State or Local Government ID, Passport, Military ID, USCG Merchant Mariner Credential.
- Person(s) requesting un-escorted access must possess a valid TWIC.
- A PTCSC approved TWIC Escort must escort all non-TWIC holders at all times while in the Port.
- To become an Approved TWIC Escort additional training is required per 33 CFR 105.215.
- **NO weapons, firearms, alcohol or illicit drugs allowed on facility.**
- **NO UNAUTHORIZED PHOTOGRAPHY.**
- No unauthorized access to any area designated as "**RESTRICTED**".
- No unauthorized parking on dock apron or next to or between cargos.
- **All** vehicle occupants must swipe their access badge for entry into internal Port gates at Docks 14, 16, 20 & 56/57. After passing through a dock gate, the vehicle driver must wait 15-20 feet past the gate until the gate is fully closed behind the vehicle before proceeding further. **Do not allow other vehicles to enter behind your vehicle before the gate closes.**
- All gate entries are logged by time, name and authorization.
- All cargo and vessel stores entering the Port must have supporting documentation.
- **Everyone has a civic duty to report suspicious persons and activity (e.g. anyone not adhering to the policy outlined on this document) to the PTCSC Security Operations center at (409) 948-1991; if considered life-threatening contact 911.**
- Our levels of alert are identified by U. S. Coast Guard MARSEC Levels, identified by:
  - **Level 1** – Normal daily security measures taken.
  - **Level 2** – Heightened threat of an unlawful act against a Port or Vessel.
  - **Level 3** – The threat is probable or imminent, possible temporary closure.
- Screening measures of personnel, vehicles, cargo, and deliveries will be conducted in accordance with existing MARSEC Level and in accordance with the Port's Facility Security Plan.
- All traffic and safety signs in Port must be obeyed at all times; the speed limit in the Port is 20 mph.
- Parking at the Port's Main Gate/SOC parking is limited to a maximum of 60 minutes. Vehicles left unattended for more than 60 minutes will be subject to towing at owner's/driver's expense.
- PTCSC Security personnel patrol this facility and monitor port activity via cameras.
